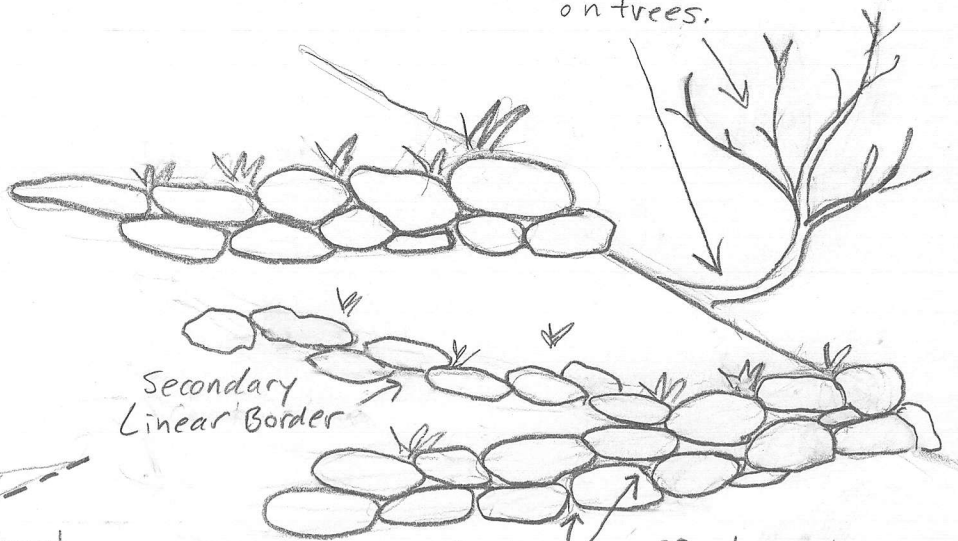

Dry Laid Rock Wall

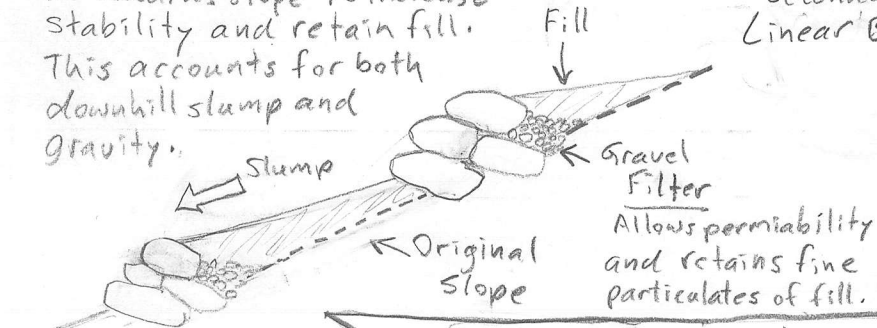
The effects of Slump on trees.



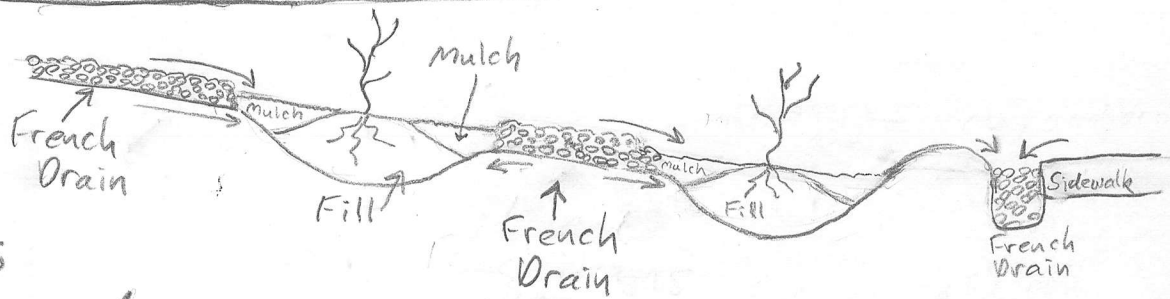
Dry laid rocks are angled in towards slope to increase stability and retain fill. This accounts for both downhill slump and gravity.

Secondary Linear Border

Rocks are offset and backed with gravel filters to retain fill.



Linked French Drains and Mulch Basins



Berm to prevent Run off

Raised area for plants that need high drainage and xeric plantings

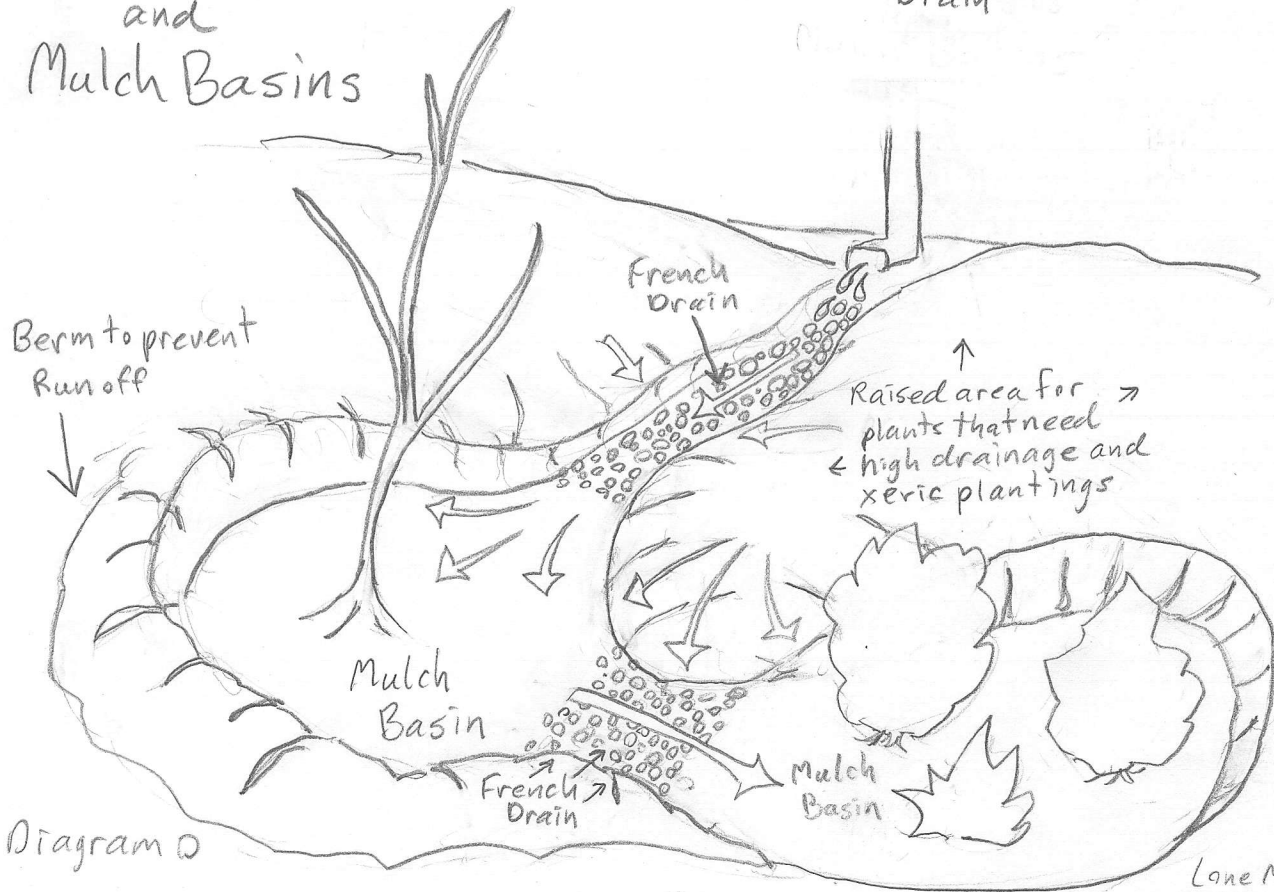
